#### OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD KICKOFF



For the last 8 years, Maranatha Christian Schools has been committed to blessing children with gift-filled gospel-opportunity shoe boxes. Last year, our collection and packing efforts reached an all-time high when we sent out 1,319 shoeboxes, which were mostly shipped to the Philippines and Indonesia. MCS' goal this year is to ship 1,500 shoeboxes.

#### THE TRANSFORMATION IS COMPLETE!



## ATHLETICS GIRLS GOLF OFF TO GREAT START



In their first ever year of having a team, the Maranatha Christian Girls Golf team is off to a very successful start. They currently sit at 8-1, beating league opponents Bishops Academy, La Jolla Country Day, Francis Parker, and Santa Fe Christian. They are currently atop the Coastal League with an 8-0 record and are ranked 35th in the county with team differential of 92.12.

The team is led by senior Maddy Skotte who leads the team with a differential of 12.46 and an average score of 45. She is ranked 136th in the county out of 524 golfers and is expected to be one of the top golfers in Division 2.

Sydney Lee and the Chackle sisters, Ali and Catie are the other top performers on the team. Sydney is second on the team with a differential of 14.47 which is 167th in San Diego County. Ali has a differential of 19.53 and Catie currently has a 20.94.






