This year's Arts and Cultural trip was our best one yet! Our amazing group of 25 traveled to Italy and spent 7 days in the cities of Rome, Florence, and Venice.

We saw the birthplace of the Roman Empire, with its magnificent architectural ruins, including the Roman Forum, the Colosseum, the Circus Maximus, and the Pantheon. We were blown away by the artistic wonders held by the Vatican, the breathtaking Sistine Chapel, the Trevi Fountain, the Spanish Steps, and the incredible collection of the Borghese Museum. We heard beautiful music at several concerts, ate mouthwatering foods, drank delicious coffee, and indulged in way too much gelato!

In Florence we explored the birthplace of the Renaissance. We beheld artwork by some of the greatest and most influential artists in history at the Uffizi Museum, the Academia, and Santa Maria Novella. We roamed through the tiny medieval streets, strolled across the Ponte Vecchio, and were overwhelmed by the massive Duomo towers over the city. We again listened to several music performances, ate Bistecca Flourentine (the best steak we have ever had), and once again also ate too much gelato.



We then traveled to the unreal city of Venice, where we floated in boats down the Grand Canal, adventured through the labyrinth of alleyways, bridges, and waterways, explored San Marco Square and the cathedral, and took a memorable gondola ride at sunset. We went to a violin museum, saw the Doges Palace, ate delicious seafood pasta, a variety of pizzas, and finished off the trip with a Vivaldi concert of the Four Seasons in the church that Vivaldi had originally performed in. The students were all brought to tears at the beautiful sound the strings made together in harmony as they reverberated throughout the old Baroque style church. We then celebrated a wonderful tour with, you guessed it, more delicious gelato!

It was an incredible trip filled with lots of laughing, a ton of learning, and exposure to different time periods throughout history, innovative and creative ways of thinking, and new cultural ideas. It was also a trip filled with wonderful conversations where new relationships were built. God definitely blessed our trip and we give Him all the glory!


PRESCHOOL NEWS
