We are closed Friday, April 19 in observance of Good Friday, and closed from Monday, April 22 to Friday, April 26 for Easter break. Have a blessed Easter!

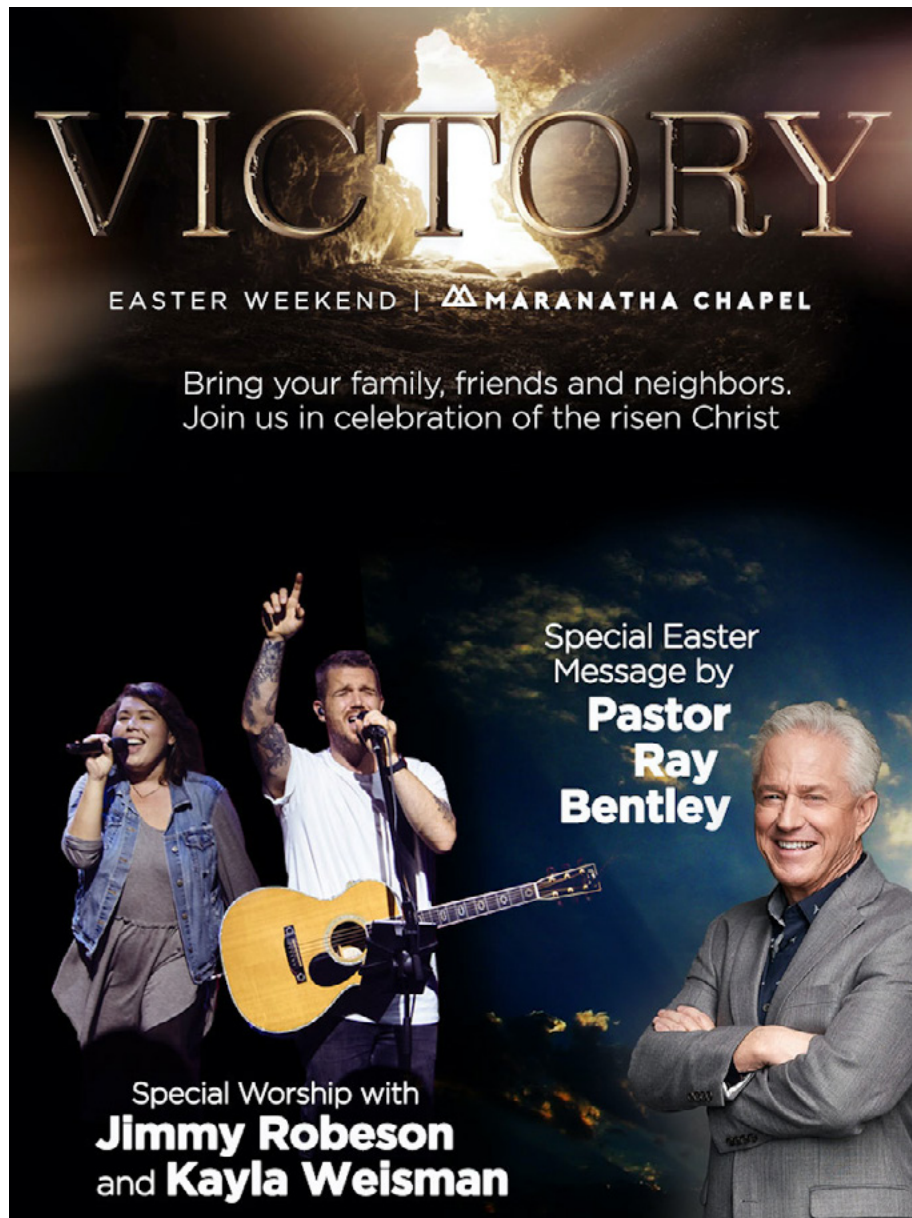

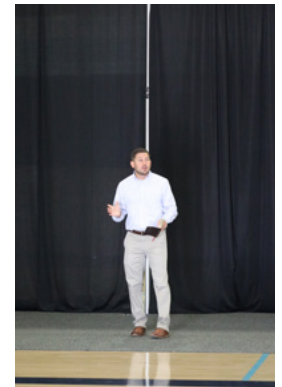

#### **HIP HOP TO TK: M-F for 3 weeks (1<sup>st</sup> Session only) \$525**

Engaging activities will be provided to develop critical thinking skills through hands-on math and science discovery. #### **JUMP START TO KINDERGARTEN: M-F for 3 weeks \$525**
