#### **HYDROBOTS GIVE THE GIFT OF CLEAN WATER**



The HydroBots Robotics Team enjoyed full access to The Makery this month, presenting a science lesson to their fellow 5th grade students. The team researched and created water filters from a turkey basters, cotton balls, activated charcoal and crumpled paper coffee filters. A simple and clever design, the water filter allows unclean water to be dripped through the top of a turkey baster. As the water filters through the contents of the funnel, it becomes clean and ready to drink at the other end.

All of the supplies used for the 'teaching part' of the project were readily available in the Makery: pencils, paper (for funnels) and a projection screen. After the lesson was taught by the students, classes went to work on constructing additional filters to be included in Operation Christmas Child boxes sponsored by the HydroBots Robotics Team.

The HydroBots funded 45 emergency water filters and sanitation kits, complete with 'pictograph' instructions, as part of their fully packed OCC boxes. The gift of the Makery will keep on giving when the water filters are distributed around the world next month to bless underprivileged children.
