## THE SENIOR GIFT - A LASTING LEGACY OF LOVE



Every year a beautiful tradition takes place at the end of the school year when the graduating class presents a permanent gift to the school. In past years we have been blessed with a decorative plaque mounted on a boulder which is located between the HS Multipurpose Room, an iron cross in our courtyard, a beautiful Magnolia tree, a concrete bench engraved with Psalm 61:2, and a sidewalk mosaic in the shape of a compass.

This year, on behalf of the Class of 2018, Senior Class Division Coordinator Patti Hepner will unveil a stunning bronze plaque to be placed over the gym archway at the main entrance of the building. In honor of school tradition, the plaque will bear MCS' founding scripture, Isaiah 40:31, along with an image of a soaring eagle.

Patti said the idea of the plaque started at the beginning of the school year when she met with Senior Class President, Nathan Self to spearhead the effort. After collaborating with students and parents and even conducting a student vote with the help of Mrs. Gray, the eagle plaque won the popular vote.

Students raised a portion of the funds through Blue Crew while the balance was gifted by our wonderful MCS parents. One of the parents didn't even have a child in the class of 2018, but when they heard about the plaque, they fell in love with the idea, and gave very generously.

Patti went to work coordinating the design and material composition of the plaque through the manufacturer. After gaining approval from Mr. Plotnik and Mr. Hetherington and vetting the colors through Harper Construction, the plaque was well on its way to completion.

According to Patti, the plague is scheduled to arrive before the end of the school year, when she hopes to have a small dedication ceremony together with the graduating class.

"It is a beautiful tradition that each graduating class can leave a lasting imprint and legacy from their class to the school. It was such a big project...I am grateful it happened," said Patti recently.

We would like to add that we are thankful for you, Patti. Your servant leadership has touched our hearts, as well as the many students and parents who quietly work behind the scenes to make our school the incredible place it is today.


