Application Process:

- Confirm that you've met the <u>minimum</u> English proficiency requirements (within the last 6 months).
 - iTep/SLATE-Plus: 4.0+ (All Grades) https://www.itepexam.com/ (Preferred; Online with 24-hour results)
 - Duolingo 85+ (All Grades)
 - TOEFLiBt: 60+ (Grades 9-12)
 - TOEFL Jr: 800+ (Grades 6-8 only)
 - \circ IELTS: 5.5+ (All grades)
- 2. Complete & submit the online International Student Application (available annually beginning November 1)

- 3. Email all Supplemental Documents (If you did not submit them all with the initial application.)
- 4. Pay the **non-refundable** \$400 Application Fee using the link provided in the application
- 5. Virtual Interview with MCS
- 6. Admissions Decision (within 48 hours)
- 7. If accepted, pay Tuition & Fees *in full* (non-refundable except in the event of <u>documented</u> Visa denial)
- 8. I-20 issued by MCS to student
- 9. Schedule Visa Appointment \rightarrow Visa Interview \rightarrow Visa Issued
- 10. Obtain a Host Family & Plane Ticket (MCS can provide referrals if needed)
- 11. Begin School!

Supplemental Document Checklist:

- □ Guardianship Agreement with Copy of ID & proof of legal residence <u>All</u> international students must have a qualified U.S. Guardian no exceptions. (If you do not have one, MCS partners with agencies who can provide that for you.)
- US Transfer Students Only) Letters of Recommendation
- US Transfer Students Only) Request for Student Permanent Records
