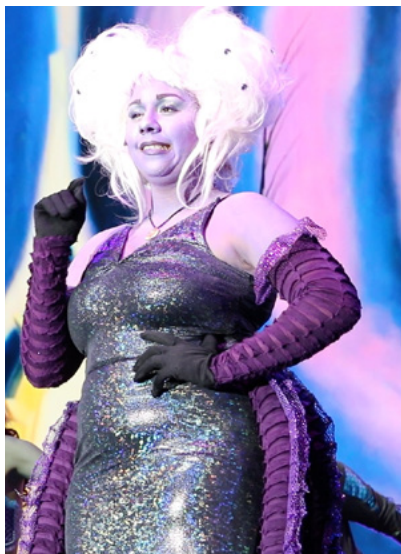

SUMMER 2019 ACADEMICS & ENRICHMENT CLASSES

Open to Community; 2 Sessions, 3 wks. each (6/24-7/12) & (7/15-8/2). Gates open at 7:30am for paid early drop off

HIP HOP TO TK: M-F for 3 weeks (1st Session only) \$525

Come give your little one an opportunity to build a strong foundation for TK. Students will enhance their skills in oral language, vocabulary, phonological awareness, and alphabetic. Engaging activities will be provided to develop critical thinking skills through hands-on math and science discovery. Give your child a head start for their new experience in Transitional Kindergarten.

JUMP START TO KINDERGARTEN: M-F for 3 weeks \$525

Give your child an opportunity to build friendships and get prepared for when school starts. Your child will enjoy learning reading, writing, math, and many more activities. Socially the kids will work on separation transition and direction following. Academically the kids will focus on visual memory and comprehension skills along with using fine/gross motor skills. Come join us and get a jump start to Kindergarten.

READY, SET, GO TO 1ST GRADE: M-F for 3weeks \$545

Make a smooth transition into 1st grade with fun activities designed to get the brain stimulating. Our phonic games, reading strategies, writing, math, and art concepts will get your child ready for first grade with a positive attitude after this fun exciting summer review class motivating them to jump into the school year!

2nd -3rd Grade ENGLISH CLASS: M-F for 3weeks \$545

Students will choose one piece of writing to take through the writing process and publish. All students will receive an anthology with a piece of writing from each camper. **This class is for students who complete grade to enroll in class.**

2nd -3rd Grade MATH: M-F for 3weeks \$545

Help your child to be a "Math Master" investigating connections with numbers, fractions, decimals and knowledge as they build mathematical self-confidence through activities, worksheets and games. Students will explore basic math skills needed to solve problems while having fun at the same time. Come join us! **This class is for students who completed the grade to enroll in class.**

4th-5th Grade MATH: M-F for 3weeks \$545

Come get a solid understanding in fractions, division, and multiplication. Review many basic skills needed to move forward into the next grade level and work on problem solving to connect mathematical ideas. Concepts reinforced will be included in multiplication, division, facts mastery, number sense, place value, multiplication, geometry, fractions and algebraic reasoning. Math games played for reinforcement along with having fun. Math workbook is included to help students at their current level or advance them to the next level. **Must complete grade to enroll in class.**

K- 8th Grade INDOOR/OUTDOOR SPORTS & GAMES: M,W,F (\$340) or T,TH (\$250) for 3 weeks

Does your child love sports? We play all kinds of sports in this camp. How about indoor and outdoor games? This class is for them! 2nd -6th KIDS CAN COOK: M,W,F (\$340) or T,TH (\$250) for 3weeks

Active chefs will be busy chopping, measuring, stirring, rolling, baking and eating their yummy creations they make. 2nd – 6th S.T.E.A.M. CLASS: M,W,F for 3 weeks \$340

Come weather watching and work of water with us! Students will learn about weather and the power of water using critical thinking skills engaging in fun hands on activities while working collaboratively. Students develop skills to become weather watchers recognizing weather patterns and predict changes happening. Come learn water powerful forces that reshape the Earth surface by carrying sand to create beaches, carving out canyons and valleys. Scrape entire areas flat and watch ice form. Water is so much more than just something we drink.

K-3rd Grade ART & CRAFTS: M,W,F for 3weeks \$340

Come have fun with art & crafts. We will be rolling up your sleeves making your own masterpiece to take home made from all kinds ecofriendly art projects using glue, paste, color markers and pencils, cutting, drawing, clay and making lots of fun projects all to take home. Junior High Summer Classes - 2019

6th-8th Grade JR. HIGH MATH: M-F 9am-12pm for 3 weeks \$545

Our small class sizes are an excellent opportunity to brush up on math skills. Review pre-algebra, algebra, geometry, integers, fractions, reasoning skills on master parts of an equation. Our math teacher uses hands-on approach to review problems solving, decimals and percentages. There will also be lots of repetitions for students to develop confidence in their ability to solve math problems step-by-step. This gives students a solid understanding of the math concepts learned through pre-algebra, algebra preparing students to go into the next level of math. Come join us and master math while you have fun! No homework or grades assigned in this class. **This class is for students who complete grade to enroll in class.**

6th-8th Grade JR. HIGH ENGLISH WRITING CLASS: M-F 9am-12pm for 3 weeks \$545

Come join this writing class allowing students to read literature, informational articles and more. Learn how to fuel a love for writing in our small class sizes give students an opportunity to master detailed meaningful sentences and paragraphs that skill them for Common Core State Standards. Come have fun, keep up on your writing while you learn and be ready for the next school year! No homework or grades assigned in this class. **This class is for students who complete grade to enroll in class.**

7th-8th Grade INTRO TO COMPUTER: M-F 12pm-4pm for 3 weeks \$545 (2nd Session only)

This introductory computer course provides each student with the opportunity to learn the basics of Microsoft office computer skills. In addition to keyboarding techniques, students will learn and practice using Word, PowerPoint, and Excel programs. Students will also be introduced to computer programming using online resources and the Scratch programming platform. The students who complete this course will be ready to use technology to complete academic research for educational and other uses.

This elective class for MCS students to can be waived by passing a hands-on computer test in class.

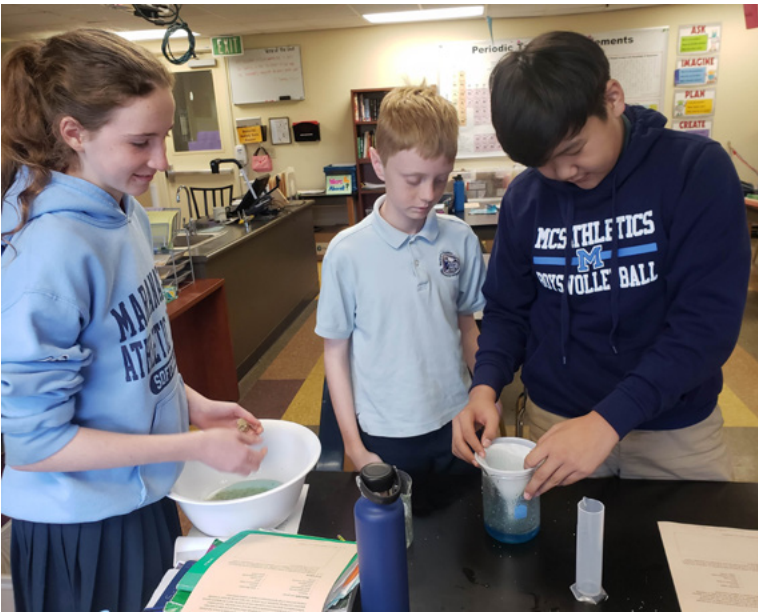
