NOAH RUPP FINISHES STRONG

Congratulations to Noah Rupp for an amazing wrestling season! In addition to his numerous victories throughout the season, Rupp finished the season as a CIF Champion, placed 2nd at Masters, and qualified for the California Wrestling State Championship. Whereas other high school sports feed into various divisions and have multiple state championships, wrestling only has one. All California high schools, regardless of size, feed into one state tournament and only the top 40 at each weight class are invited.

Noah Rupp, representing Maranatha Christian Schools, was in the elite top 40 class this year as the #31 seed. He placed in the top 16, falling two matches short of being a state placer. He put on a strong and worthy performance going 3-2, including two big upsets. Noah definitely made a name for himself and put MCS on the wrestling community's radar. Most impressively, Rupp did it all without the support of a team. As most everyone knows, Rupp is the sole wrestler for MCS.
