

MCS Youth Summer Theatre Arts Camps

COVID-19 Guidelines

All parents/guardians of participants will be required to sign a commitment to adhere to the following requirements prior to the first day of camp.

Drop off and Pick up:

All participants will enter/exit the campus through the main gate. No parents/guardians will be allowed to enter through the main gate during the camp days.

Daily Screening:

All participants, teachers and leaders will be screened for signs/symptoms of COVID-19 prior to entrance to the campus. Screening includes a temperature check. Daily responses/results will be recorded on a MCS monitoring form.

Any participant with a temperature of 100 degrees or more will be sent home.

Any person with positive symptoms reported will not be permitted on campus and should seek his or her primary care provider or other health professional. In order to return to the camp participants must be clear of all Covid-19 symptoms.

All participants will be encouraged to wash or sanitize their hands before entering the campus. Hand sanitizer will be available for all participants.

Limitations on Gatherings

The camp will be for participants only, no other spectators or parents will be allowed on campus during the camp day.

Participants will be divided into grade groups of no more than 12 students.

A minimum distance of 6 feet between each participant should be maintained when not directly involved in a musical number or performance.

End of Camp Day:

All participants must leave the facility at the end of their camp day.

All Elementary participants will be escorted out the main gate by their leader to be picked up by a parent or guardian. All other participants will exit the campus through the main gate.

General Guidelines

Participants will be encouraged to wash and sanitize their hands frequently.

Participants may bring a snack in a brown throw away bag only. Water containers are allowed, please no water bottles. There will be no sharing of food or drinks allowed.

Participants will not be required to wear face masks during the camp day or during performances. Teachers and Leaders will be required to wear face shields or masks.
