Who is eligible for Eagle Academy?

- Families feeling called to homeschool their elementary-aged students
- Families with a parent at home to homeschool
- Grades K-5

How to apply?

- Once match is established, family completes Eagle Academy online application

What can an Eagle Academy family expect from our program?

- One full day a week of enrichment class held on the campus of Maranatha Chapel (enrichment includes Bible, art, STEM, language arts, cooking activities, etc.)
- Choice of curriculum from MCS approved list (can submit curriculum to us for approval if desired curriculum is not on list) to be used on homeschooling days
- Access to after school programs held at MCS (i.e. Robotics)
- Academic counseling; accountability to Eagle Academy Coordinator by regularly turning in gradebooks and work samples every 6 weeks
- Access to weekly chapels held on MCS campus
- Students obtain an accredited transcript from MCS (under WASC and ASCI Accreditation)
- Homeschooling and alternative education support and fellowship with homeschooling families in the community

Expectations of Eagle Academy families

- Maintain an active gradebook for all homeschooled courses (user friendly template is available upon request)
- Assign and grade assignments for student (EA staff can help determine pacing of curriculum for parents)
- Turn in work samples & current course grades every 6 weeks
- Proctored testing for core subjects once every 6 weeks by Eagle Academy staff (can be done in-person or virtually)
- No dual enrollment
