

WHAT IS EAGLE ACADEMY?

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

- ✓ 1 of the EA student's parents must be a professing believer in Jesus Christ
- ✓ Applicants for 9th - 12th grade must have a history of homeschooling (exclusive of pandemic period distance learning). This excludes students applying before the start of their 9th grade year.
- ✓ Parents are responsible for the daily monitoring of their student's work. Under EA guidelines, a parent must be home with a junior high EA student during standard school hours. Other family members or hired individuals are not to replace parent supervision.

WHAT CAN AN EA STUDENT EXPECT FROM OUR PROGRAM?

- ✓ participation in CIF athletics and Performing Arts productions
- ✓ participation in our JH & HS Student Life Activities: annual retreats, weekly chapels, pep rallies, dances, clubs and much more
- ✓ academic counseling for HS career
- ✓ option to take up to 3 classes on campus from any of our course offerings, including core subjects, music, art, theater, electives, foreign languages, science labs, AP and Honors courses.
- ✓ graduation with a diploma from MCS (under WASC and ACTS accreditation)
- ✓ option to take external and college courses for HS credit
- ✓ collaborate with EA Dept. to select home-taught courses and curriculum that best meet needs of students & family
- ✓ have core subject (math, history, science & English) assessments proctored each grading period (every 6 weeks)

CAN A TRADITIONAL STUDENT TRANSFER INTO EA?

- ✓ all above requirements apply, plus...
- ✓ once enrolled in 9th grade, in our traditional (on-campus) program, transfer opportunities are limited and may only be approved by the Division Principal for extraordinary circumstances
- ✓ mid-year transfers out of the traditional, full-time program will not be accepted
- ✓ financially motivated interests on behalf of a traditional student desiring to transfer to the EA program will not be approved by the Division Principal

WHAT CAN AN EA PARENT EXPECT FROM OUR PROGRAM?

- ✓ choose curriculum from our Approved Curriculum List, with guidance from EA Department, and purchase for student
- ✓ turn in work samples and active grade books each 6 weeks for all home-taught courses
- ✓ if student is taking an external course, screenshot of student's progress & current grade is to be turned in with each packet of work samples
- ✓ meet, or speak with Director of EA on an as needed basis
